

## **PSYCHIATRIC NURSE PRACTITIONER**

### **Job Summary and Responsibilities:**

The full time Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner will work in a non-profit health care environment providing assessments and implement treatment planning in conjunction with the treatment team for consumers admitted to the program. The successful candidate will be responsible for directing and supervising activities of the health advocates; and performs assessments and prescribes treatments to consumers.

### **Position Qualifications:**

A current license to practice as a registered Nurse in the State of Michigan **is required**.

Certification by the American Nurse Credentialing Center (ANCC) as a Certified Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner by the State of Michigan Board of Nursing.

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Graduation from an accredited school of nursing with a Master of Science Degree in Nursing is also required.

At least two-three years experience.

Valid State of Michigan driver’s license and good driving record. proof of current auto insurance required

Experience working with persons with serious mental illness is preferred.

Successful candidate will conduct medication reviews, assist with the Psychiatric assessment routine scheduled patients and prescribe medication under the supervision of the Psychiatrist.

Good verbal and written skills.

Ability to work well as part of a multi-disciplinary team.

Excellent customer service orientation skills necessary in order to deal effectively with various levels of agency personnel, outside customers, and community groups.

**Essential Duties:**

Under general direction, obtains, assesses, evaluates and documents patient psychiatric history, in consultation with and under guidance of the physician.

Under general direction, assess, evaluate and document physical health status, including physical examination, laboratory and clinical data in consultation with and under guidance of the physician.

Formulate and implement treatment plan for the coordination of health care for medically fragile consumers in conjunction with the multidisciplinary treatment team.

Direct the assignments of the medical health advocates working with the medically fragile consumers.
